- Ad should be in color, 200 dpi minimum resolution, in jpeq or pdf format, with active website links
- Advertiser is responsible for supplying ad (design service available for a fee)
- Advertising contracts are for 12 months; cost is prorated for ads booked after Jan. 1
- Advertisers may change ad each month (new ad due by 15th of month preceding issue date)

GMDM NEWSLETTER INSERT RATES AND SPECS

We also accept advertising inserts in the newsletter. These are full-page marketing pieces that are the same size as the newsletter page (8 $1/2 \times 11$) that are inserted into a monthly newsletter. The cost is \$250 for a single-page insert or \$350 for a two-sided (front and back) insert.

Inserts are a great way for an organization to communicate more detailed information than is possible in an ad. For example, you might share background on a new provider joining your practice, detail services your company offers that would be of interest to GMDM members, or provide details on an expansion – all with click-throughs directly to your website.

In addition to being included in the online newsletter, inserts also are printed and distributed at GMDM luncheons, providing in-person, hands-on exposure.

Inserts are booked on a monthly basis. The advertiser is responsible for creating the insert; however, design services are available for a fee, if needed.
