Q: What are the new proposed rules for telemedicine and controlled substances?

A: The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) recently published new proposed rules for distribution of controlled substances via telemedicine.

In the past, before COVID-19, a person had to have an in-person visit before a controlled substance could be prescribed. During the public health emergency, an exception was allowed. The public health emergency will end in May 2023 and with it these exceptions.

The new proposed rules would allow prescribers to issue an initial 30-day supply of Schedule III, IV, or V non-narcotic controlled medications, and buprenorphine if for the treatment of opioid use disorder, without an in-person evaluation.

This will allow some flexibility for practitioners. There will also be record-keeping rules requiring very detailed documentation for the prescriptions. Practices will need to update themselves on these new requirements. More info: dea.gov


