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
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
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### **GMDM Food Drive Is in April**

### Help for a Child Who Lost His Mother to Homicide



GMDM member Skylar Maddox, a former preschool teacher, shared the following heartbreaking story, along with the QR code at left for a GoFundMe to benefit her former student:

"On February 11, 2025, in Burlington, NC, there was a murder-suicide that has completely turned upside down the life of 6-year-old Ezra. Whitney Huston, his loving mother (shown at left with Ezra), was fatally shot by someone it is said she was in a domestic relationship with. Then the shooter took his own life. Unfortunately, Ezra was in the home and heard it happen. The 6-year-old FaceTimed his biological father images from the

scene, and his father then called the authorities.

I taught Ezra in past years and knew Whitney well. She was Ezra's whole

#### WHICH COLISEUM PARKING ENTRANCE TO USE:


